

## Plan International Hong Kong 'Be a Change-maker 2020' Application Guidelines

'Be a Change-maker 2020' aims to nurture young people who have an interest in exploring social and child protection issues as 'Change-makers'. Participants will take the first step to becoming global citizens through learning, researching, and taking action to make a voice for children around the world, especially for girls in poverty and dire situations.

- ✓ Understanding child safeguarding and girl issues in Northern Thailand and Hong Kong.
- Cultivating project management and leadership skills throughout the planning and execution of Seed Project
- ✓ Taking initiatives and making a voice on child-safeguarding and girl issues that matter to youth.
- Realizing participant's full potential as a change-maker with a global perspective and the ability to advocate for the rights for young people.

## Eligibility :

- Aged between 15 and 21 (as of the departure date of the exposure trip)
- Have a passion for global citizenship and child-safeguarding issues
- Willing to take action to advocate for children and youth rights, and to make a voice for children around the world, especially girls in poverty and dire situation.
- Priority will be given to applicants who :
  - have joined youth activities organized by Plan International Hong Kong; and/or
  - with recommendations from school teachers/affiliated organisations (Appendix 1)

#### **Important Note:**

- 16 shortlisted participants will be selected by Plan International Hong Kong (hereafter as 'Plan International') based on the information provided by applicants. Applicants may be invited to attend the interview session on 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2019 (Saturday). Plan International reserves the right to cancel the programme if application is insufficient.
- 2. Applicants should return the completed application form, together with i) photocopy of applicant's HKID card, ii) photocopy of applicant's travel document (personal information page), and iii) copy of academic year 2019-20 school calendar to Plan International Hong Kong via email or post. Except in special circumstances, an application will not be accepted if the information in the application form is incorrect, incomplete or insufficient, or the applicant does not meet the eligible requirements.
- 3. The fee covers the costs of local workshops, flights, overseas transportation, food, accommodation, and travel insurance of the exposure trip, but does not cover the costs of immunization and visa application. If a shortlisted participant withdraws from the programme, all fee paid will not be refunded.
- 4. Participants should participate in all pre-trip and post-trip activities.
- 5. Applicants under the age of 18 should also complete the parent/ guardian consent form.
- 6. All submitted applications are non-transferable. •
- 7. Participants should abide by Plan International's Child Safeguarding guidelines and policy, and should follow the instructions as given from all event working personnel throughout the duration of the events.
- 8. Plan International reserves the right to disqualify any participants who violate the regulations or have any misbehaviour, and to discontinue their participation in the event immediately.
- 9. Participants should be responsible for their own safety during the events and bear the rise of damage which might be caused by accident or else. Plan International is not liable for any harm caused to the participants during the activities.
- 10. Participants should take care of their personal belongings during the events. The organiser is not liable for any claims concerning missed or damaged personal possessions.
