Like your sponsored child, Tarannum has been empowered by Plan International to change her life. Tarannum has tops marks in her grade, and she's excited about what the future holds for her. She and her three siblings are all enrolled at good schools and can access government programmes, thanks to their new identity cards.

I Am Here

Tarannum's parents moved to Delhi in search of work. Her father was the only earner, and it was hard for him to make ends meet.

Government supports for income and food existed, but the family didn't have the proper identity cards. The documents were also needed for admission into secondary school.

After joining Plan International's child sponsorship program, Tarannum learned about the importance of having identity documents to claim her rights and access the supports she's entitled to.

Tarannum and her family now have their identity cards, and they can play an active role as full citizens in their community.

Family Support

COVID-19 has been hard on Tarannum. Her father lost his job, and it became a struggle to provide food for the family, even with government programmes.

While distributing face masks and hygiene kits to help keep children and families safe from the virus, Plan International also provided financial support. Through this support, Tarannum's parents were able to purchase nutritious food for her and her siblings.

Tarannum is dreaming big for her future, and her parents are giving her all the support she needs to reach her goals.

OUR PROJECTS IN HYDERABAD SOUTH ARE HELPING CHILDREN THRIVE



Parents and children maintained good health and hygiene during the pandemic





Many families in Hyderabad South struggled during the COVID-19 pandemic. Parents lost their jobs and access to hygiene items was limited. Tuberculosis is also a constant threat in the area which can cause serious health issues.

More than 1,400 families received hygiene kits with face masks and soap to protect themselves from COVID-19. Kits also included sanitary pads, so girls could continue to manage their menstruation with dignity.

Through awareness events, families in 25 communities improved their knowledge on how to prevent and treat tuberculosis. Community health volunteers also visited families to check on their health and support them with referrals to local health centres for treatment.

And early childhood centres have new water filters, ensuring more than 3,400 children and mothers can access safe drinking water while they learn and play.

INCLUSIVE EDUCATION



We provided tablets to 764 children so they could access digital libraries and join online classes in the safety of their homes. And teachers also took part in training sessions on how to teach with digital technologies, helping to keep students engaged and learning while outside the classroom.

More than 3,000 children also received education kits with textbooks, reading materials, and workbooks. And through community outreach, 47 children who had dropped out rejoined their school lessons. Girls and boys can now continue their education and reach their full potential.
