

# ANNUAL UPDATE GUATEMALA POLOCHIC





Together with your sponsorship, children and families are making positive changes in Polochic. Learn more about the valuable ways we work with children and communities.

Polochic is a small region, home to just 40,516 people. Vulnerable to the effects of climate change, the people of Polochic are threatened by landslides, forest fires and flooding. Thanks to your support, we have been able to provide 822 scholarships to students in need. Young people completed comprehensive sexual and reproductive health and rights training, part of our effort to reduce high rates of teen pregnancy and gender-based violence in this area.

#### **Meet María**

Like the child you sponsor, María is determined to build a bright future for herself.

Maria is a clever, ambitious student from rural Guatemala. The oldest of nine siblings, no obstacles have been strong enough to get in the way of María's determination.

#### **Knowledge Is Power**

In María's community, many young women either are married off at a young age or move to the United States in the hopes of better work. Making matters still more complicated, María's immediate community is home to only a primary school, and the closest secondary school is far away.

Still, María has always been determined to stay in school and support her family. As a Sponsored Child of Plan International, María enrolled in Plan's "Connections for Success" programme, where she learned about empowerment, entrepreneurship and business management. At the end of the workshop, María won seed funding to start her own small business, a grocery store.

#### **Nothing Can Stop Me**

From the outside, María is a force to be reckoned with. A strong maths student and an aspiring maths teacher, modest María attributes her success to Plan's Leadership School, where she learned about her rights and the importance of determination. Today, María is a vocal advocate of girl's rights and the importance of education. "My advice to girls and adolescents is: keep studying and learn about your rights and self-esteem," María tells us.

# **OUR PROJECTS IN POLOCHIC ARE HELPING CHILDREN THRIVE**



This year, our projects in Polochic focused on nurturing the leadership skills of young people, particularly girls and young women.

## **BUDDING BOOKWORMS**



Less than 55% of women in Polochic are literate.

In collaboration with teachers at the primary and secondary school levels, we worked to make reading and maths more accessible to young people in Polochic through our Lecto and Mate teaching programmes. In total, students at 14 schools across the region used a combination of worksheets and technology (tablets) to keep pace with their grade level and have fun at the same time.

We spoke with local parents to emphasise the value of keeping girls in school, underlining topics of gender equality, self-esteem and economic empowerment.







In 2022, 29 cases of acute malnutrition in children under 5 were reported in Polochic.

The last year, we have worked with local parents and health care workers to improve the well-being of children in Polochic, particularly those who are under 5 years old. Caregivers learned about the importance of breastfeeding and practised cooking nutritious meals, avoiding non-nutritious foods. 38 midwives learned about the role of breastfeeding in early childhood development, and received new tools to provide sanitary, hygienic care. 45 mothers took on additional leadership roles in their community, bolstering their knowledge about livestock, including vaccination, diseases and home hygiene. Today, these mothers raise broiler chickens for their families.
